Sample Short Response Questions

1. Several factors contributed to the Patriot victory in the Revolutionary War. Choose the three factors that you consider the most important to the American Victory and explain how each one affected the war's outcome.
2. What were the three biggest mistakes of the British political and military leaders between 1775 and 1783? Explain.
3. Summarize the strengths and weaknesses of the Articles of Confederation.
4. Describe the Legislative Branch of the US government.
5. Persuading the 13 original states to support a new constitution for the US required a number of compromises. Explain how the US Constitution was developed through a series of THREE compromises.
6. The framers of the Constitution used the best ideas from a variety of sources. Explain how the Roman Republic, British Traditions, and ideas of the Enlightenment helped shape the US government.
7. Explain how the ratification of the Constitution was threatened by disagreements between Federalists and Antifederalists. Define the position of each side and explain how the differences were resolved.
