These are sample questions that could be asked. Not all will be asked because there isn't enough time. They may not take this precise form. Things covered on the November essay will mostly not be addressed on the exam.

1. Describe how the dependence on buffalo hunting affected the lives of the Plains Indians.
2. Explain how railroads promoted growth of the United States territory and economy in the period after the Civil War.
3. Describe the boom and bust of the Cattle Kingdom.
4. Using the wars with the Sioux (Lakotas) and Apache as examples, relate the cause and effects of Indian wars.
5. What actions were taken by government and private citizens in an attempt to remedy the Indian question in the late 1800s? How well did the measures work?
6. Explain how rebates and pools could be used to consolidate a railroad business.
7. Explain how a corporation works and what it is for.
8. Relate the case for and against allowing trusts and take a side.
9. Describe how TWO inventions that revolutionized business in the late 1800s.
10. What were THREE factors that led to the rise of organized labor? Why was the success of the labor movement somewhat limited in the late 1800s in America?
