2. Explain how the United States obtained control over any TWO locations in the Pacific.
3. Compare **and** contrast the following policies toward Latin America: Roosevelt Corollary to the Monroe Doctrine, Dollar Diplomacy, Moral Diplomacy. For each, identify the president associated.
4. Evaluate Roosevelt’s “Big Stick” policy.
5. Describe United States involvement in Mexico during the early 20th century.
6. Tell the story of the Panama Canal.
7. Explain the causes of World War I.
8. Describe how the United States got involved in World War I.
9. Describe life on the “Home Front” during World War I in the United States.
10. Explain Wilson’s peace plan for Europe and evaluate how well it worked.
