1. Relate TWO important events of the Peloponnesian war. Describe the effects of the Peloponnesian War on the Greek city-states.
2. Provide an overview of Greek religious belief. Include an explanation of how their religion differed from religions of the Middle East.
3. Discuss TWO playwrights of ancient Greece. What were their major concerns and themes?
4. Describe the Greeks who revolutionized the field of writing history. What were their techniques?
5. Compare and contrast the Athenian and Spartan educational systems.
6. One of the common patterns of history involves the distribution of wealth: the number of people owning most wealth gets smaller and smaller over time, until the pressure is released by a revolution or laws designed to redistribute wealth. Explain how Athenian Greek leaders handled this situation.
7. The Persians and Spartans saw trade and commerce as indecent. Explain why they might have thought this.
8. Contrast the governing of Sparta and Athens. Include explanations of who's in charge and important features of law.
9. Describe ONE element of Greek culture that still lives on in some form in our culture today.
10. Contrast the ideas of relativism and absolutism. Give specific examples from our Greek studies.
